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### 1. Executive Summary:

*Major outcomes, results and impact of the Chair, including on national policies, in relation to its objectives as stated in Article 2 of the Chair Agreement (between the Institution and UNESCO)*

The reporting period was marked by the events and activities dedicated to the elaboration of the International Master Program on Social Transformations jointly with the UNESCO Social and Human Sciences Sector.

Besides that, four new network sections of the Chair were established in this period of time: 1) in India, at the Punjab University on Global Peace and Non Violence Studies; 2) in India, at the Mandsaur University on 4 Global E's: Education, Ethics, Entrepreneurship and Empowerment; 3) in Hong Kong, China at the International Center of Science and Education "ILS Energy" on Global Energy; 4) in the city of Belgorod, Russian Federation at the Belgorod University on Global Cooperation Studies.

The Chair established relations with Italian universities of Bologna, Urbino and Rome, as well as with the University in San Marino. With the Bologna University a joint scientific project on world university rankings was started, with the Urbino University and the University of San Marino projects of UNESCO network chairs were elaborated. In Rome at the Link University a joint International Scientific and Educational Lomonosov Center was opened early May and courses of lectures organized with the active participation of the Chair. The Chairholder Dr. Yury Sayamov gave a 16 hours course on UNESCO and international organizations system at the Link University in Rome for its MBA High Level students. Two international scientific events with the Chair participation were jointly held at the Link University on the philosophy of international relations and a book on the scientific results published.

The Chair continued to develop its project of the Interregional Network Educational Partnership "Learning to Live Sustainably in the Global World: Ecology, Health, Security" on the basis of the Chair's network section at the Institute for the Education Development Strategy of the Russian Academy of Education which embraces over 100.000 of primary school teachers and 60.000 of learners.

**2) Activities:**

*Overview of activities undertaken by the Chair during the reporting period*

After the first in Russia School on the Management of Social Transformations (MOST) held by the Chair and consultations in UNESCO in April, 2016 the Chair in continuation and development of its participation in the MOST Program and in response to the appeal of UNESCO to create educational materials for the MOST Program initiated and within 7 months period of time fulfilled the elaboration of an innovative International Master Program of Higher Education on Social Transformations along the guidelines and the structure presented to the meeting of the UNESCO Expert Committee on the MOST Program on July. 7-8, 2016.

The International Master Program on Social Transformations was presented at the 13<sup>th</sup> Ordinary Session of the Intergovernmental Council on the MOST Program in Kuala Lumpur in March, 2017. According to the Decision of the 13<sup>th</sup> Ordinary Session, the Council “further welcomes the efforts of the Russian Federation in elaboration of education programmes in the field of the MOST Strategy, notably the creation of the Masters Degree Programme “Management of Social Transformations” at Lomonosov

Moscow State University” (MOST/IGC/2017/8). Afterwards, the program was presented at the 201<sup>st</sup> Session of the UNESCO Executive Board in UNESCO Headquarters in Paris on May 2, 2017/ The Executive Board expressed in its resolution the gratitude for the Program to the Russian Federation, the Lomonosov Moscow State University and the Chair. After the approval of the Program the National Commission of the Russian Federation for UNESCO has sent a congratulatory letter to the Rector of the Lomonosov Moscow State University Acad. Victor Sadovnichy. On May 26, 2017 the Scientific Council of the Faculty of Global Processes approved and endorsed the Program on Social Transformations thus opening a new educational profile on this subject. The presentation for consideration and approval of the Program at the Scientific Council of the Lomonosov Moscow State University is scheduled for June 19, 2017. In order to discuss at the SHS Sector the further promotion of the Program with the aim to make it under UNESCO aegis an internationally applicable teaching material on MOST at the level of higher education, a group from the team of the Program elaborators composed of Prof. Natalia Smakotina, Head of the Faculty Chair on Social Problems, the Scientific Secretary of the same Chair Sc. Ass. Elena Lukashina and the Scientific Secretary of the UNESCO Chair Sc.Ass. Nina Bychkova are sent to UNESCO on June 6-10, 2017. They will also present this Progress Report to the UNESCO Chairs Coordinator Mrs. Inga Nishanian and participate at a UNESCO Conference at the Headquarters on June 7-8, 2017.

The Chair has been selected by the Science Sector and the SHS Sector among the most successful UNESCO chairs in the scientific research and invited to participate in the UNESCO Conference of scientific UNESCO chairs in Geneva, Switzerland on July 5-7, 2017.

The opening of network sections established during the reporting period was combined with the scientific conferences and festive student events.

The third network section of the Chair established in Hong Kong at “ILS Energy” is devoted to global energy studies including geopolitical, economic, social, infrastructure and urbanization matters. It enabled the Chair to join the international program of global energy studies being carried out by the “ILS Energy” and its scientific research centers in China, France, Great Britain, Monaco, Russia, Switzerland and other countries and to participate in the International Survey on Global Energy 2015-2016 the co-authors of which became the UNESCO Chairholder Dr. Yury Sayamov and the First Deputy Dean of the Faculty of Global Processes of the Lomonosov Moscow State University Dr. Ivan Aleshkovski. The festive opening of the UNESCO Network Chair in Hong Kong was proposed to be combined with the visit of the delegation of the Chair and the Faculty headed by the Dean Prof. Ilya Ilyin and the joint event with the educational scientific community of Hong Kong in the presence of the Consul General of Russia on June 13, 2017.

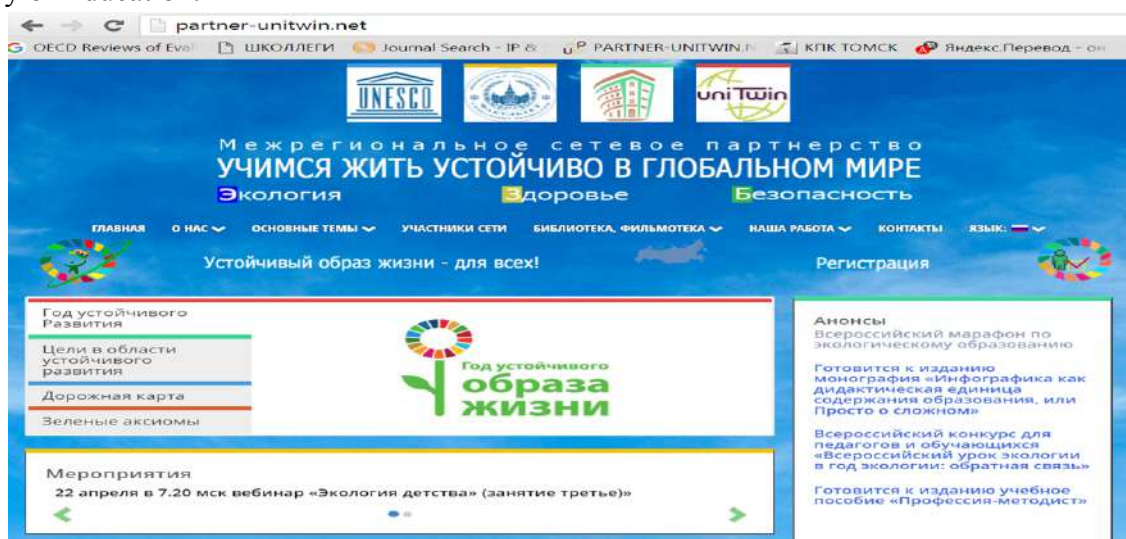
In Russia the network section of the Chair was established at the Belgorod University of Cooperation, Economics and Law on the Cooperation in the Global World.

In the reporting period the Chair continued its work on the joint project of the Interregional

Network Partnership “Learning to live sustainably in the global world: ecology, health, security” with the network section of the Chair at the Institute for the Education Development Strategy of the Russian Academy of Education.



The goal of the project is to spread the best experience of education for sustainable development. The geography of the network partnership embraces the vast territories and educational organizations of 34 regions of the Russian Federation. Participants in the network partnership are faculties of universities, colleges, schools and their teaching staff. Themes of network projects are:

- preservation of natural and cultural heritage,
- culture of "green" consumption and sustainable way of life,
- healthy lifestyle relevant to the challenges of the 21st century;
- intercultural communication and the promotion of peace;
- professional orientation of young people to be included in the "green" economy, and others.

The result of the network activities of associated organizations around the UNESCO network chair is the creation of an open bank of ESD webinars. It consists of records of speeches by scientists, teachers, politicians and is constantly replenished.

The purpose of lectures:

- to develop ESD recommendations for local education management bodies in order to enhance their understanding of the objectives and ways to reorient the work of educational organizations as well as to disseminate educational institutions' experience in implementing innovative ESD technologies as part of a whole-institution approach (WIA) at all education levels;
- to bring the results of the conference in Aichi-Nagoya, the UNESCO ESD Youth conference in Okayama and other results of the DESD to the attention of people involved in the educational policy in order to reflect the new goals and objectives in national/state policies, including the development of the National Roadmap of the Global Action Program;
- to provide widespread discussion of the results of the DESD and the GAP's long-term objectives at the national level, including, through holding national conferences to consider the objectives;
- to analyze the best world practices in ESD and to provide the information on it to interested organizations and institutions;
- to take into account historical and ethno-cultural characteristics of the population of the countries and regions in the formation of national systems of ESD;
- to enable the transition from the current ecological values in the modern society to the new culture of sustainable development, in which the position of environmental, social, and economic sustainability would find greater understanding and support.

Two network sections of the Chair at the Institute for the Development Strategy of Education of the Russian Academy of Education and at the Ecological Non-Governmental Vernadsky Foundation initiated the National Marathon on Ecological Education for Sustainable Development with the international participation. The Marathon includes a series of coordinated scientific and practical conferences, sections, round tables. The final stage of the Marathon will be the All-Russian Forum "Ecological Education for Sustainable Development" in Moscow at the Russian Academy of Education in November 2017 co-organized by the Chair and its network sections at the Russian Academy of Education and at the Russian Academy of Ecology headed by the President of the Academy Acad. Vladimir Grachev. The Chairholder Dr. Yury Sayamov is Full Member of the Russian Academy of Ecology and Head of its Section on the International Ecological Diplomacy and Cooperation..

Annual summer ecological school for teachers on the continuity of achievement of personal and meta-subject requirements of national standard of general education in the field of ecology, safety and health was held in the Irkutsk region, in the village of Large Goloustnoye in July, 2016 by the Network Section of the Chair at the Russian Academy of Education. The school was attended by participants from Irkutsk, Novosibirsk, Tomsk, Kemerovo, Moscow regions and the city of Moscow. The program of the summer school included lectures, practical classes, master classes, seminars. The participants performed 52 scientific contributions, practical tasks related to the design of conceptual images of sustainable development and the design of a development-type lesson of education for sustainable development. The reflexing of the participants showed their understanding of the complexity of the priority development tasks facing education, and the desire to enrich their knowledge in this direction through their self-education and participation in various forms of networking to share their experience with other colleagues and to expand the network of teachers' partnership.

The Network Chair at the Mandsaur University in India organized a big regional event – the International Conference on Empowerment through Education, Ethics and Entrepreneurship as the Next Agenda for BRICS on February 3-4, 2017 jointly with the Chair and with the participation of the Faculty and Lomonosov Moscow State University. Chancellor of the Mandsaur University Prof. Narendra Nahata thanked the Lomonosov Moscow State University and the Chair for establishing its Network Chair at Mandsaur University.

A special session was organized by the Network Chairholder Prof. Jagdish Khatri on April 18, 2017 on:

- Current Economic Scenario;
- Need to be Career-oriented;
- Impact of Globalization on Careers;

- Multi-Skilling and New Skill-Sets;
- Self-Analysis and Introspection Questions;
- Need to identify one's uniqueness;
- Importance of developing general awareness;
- Need to break out from Comfort Zone;
- Converting Dreams into Reality through Goal, Plan and Action.

In the reporting period the Chair continued to develop joint research and education projects with other chairs and universities. In November, 2016 the problem of the university rankings was the subject of the discussion with the Bologna University. A joint research project on rankings was established.

The Chair and the Faculty established joint projects of teaching programs, studies, student exchange, summer schools and UNESCO network chairs continued developing relationships with the University of Urbino in Italy and with the University in San Marino. The visit of the delegation of the Italian Link Campus University in Rome headed by its President, former Minister of Interior and Minister of Foreign Affairs of Italy Prof. Vincenzo Scotti to the Lomonosov Moscow State University organized by the Faculty and the Chair in October 2016 has led to the signing of the agreement on cooperation between the two universities and on the establishment of the Lomonosov Center at the Link University in Rome.

The lecture organized by the Faculty and the Chair was highly appreciated by about 800 students and professors who attended the lecture.

The UNESCO Chairholder Dr. Yury Sayamov presented the Chair and its main activities to the high guests and explained the Chair's initiative to elaborate the International Master Program on Social Transformations in response to the UNESCO appeal to create educational materials for MOST project. A sincere gratitude and appreciation of the Chair and the Faculty were expressed to Dr. Qian Tang for the development of the UNESCO Chairs Program – the UNITWIN under his leadership as the Head of the Education Sector of UNESCO. A firm conviction was expressed that UNESCO Chairs represent a powerful tool and a highly effective contemporary technology for the global promotion and dissemination of noble UNESCO ideals and principles in the interests of peace and sustainable development.

With the new Director of the UNESCO Institute for Information Technologies in Education Dr. Tao Zhan, following the first meeting, a close cooperation between the Chair and the Institute was established and the Institute was invited to participate in the “Globalistics-2017” Congress in Moscow.

The network section of the Chair in Saratov and the Vernadsky Non-governmental ecological foundation initiated the project of the integrated scientific-educational expedition “Floating Universities Fleet” in the middle and lower Volga regions. This educational technologies of the project have been tested and approved in the previous expeditions what permitted to expand the project on 3 Volga river regions of Saratov, Volgograd and Astrakhan and to establish in the framework of the expedition for the first time a Floating UNESCO Network Chair on Ecology and Sustainable Development.

The Chair continued active preparations for the International Scientific Congress “Globalistics-2017”. The topic of the congress will be global ecology and sustainable development. The Chair requested the UNESCO Patronage. It was granted by the decision of the UNESCO Director General H.E. Irina Bokova. In response to the personal invitation by the Rector of the Lomonosov Moscow State University Acad. Victor Sadovnichy the UNESCO Director General H.E. Irina Bokova agreed to attend the Congress and to speak at its opening ceremony thus honoring highly the Lomonosov Moscow University, the Faculty and the Chair by her confirmed presence at the Congress “Globalistics-2017”. After the successful achievement of the aim of including the Chair in the structure of the MSU as the full-fledged chair of the FGP, next goals are to be followed:

- the development of the Internet site and of the information program of the Chair;
- the implementation of the Program of the development of the Chair for the period till 2020 in education and scientific research approved for short, middle and long term ;
- the development of the network on the basis of the Chair to a worldwide UNESCO Chairs' structure on global problems;
- the inclusion of Chair's activities and projects in UNESCO Programs and Plans.

Expanding activities:

- the enlargement of the Chair's premises in the University through the acquisition of additional necessary space;
- the holding of the Chair's activities and events out of the University: in the premises of the institutes and scientific research centers of the Russian Academy of Sciences, of other educational establishments, federal and regional structures in Moscow, other cities in Russia, as well as with partners abroad;
- the geographic development of the network;
- the project of the Presidential library distant readers hall at the Chair.

Broadening partnerships:

- University level – partnerships with other faculties of the MSU (Politology, History, Philosophy, Economy and others);
- Interuniversity national level – partnerships with universities and other higher educational establishments in Russia;
- Interuniversity international level – partnerships with universities and other higher educational establishments all over the world.

Mobilization of resources:

- activities of the Board of Trustees to mobilize resources;
- launching of fund raising campaigns for events and actions;
- income programs of the Chair (paid activities), if approved by the University;
- support from the Moscow City Government;



- support through participation in UNESCO and member states program activities.
